Rehearsal Thursday 19 June

We will have our final rehearsal for the competition on this day before students may be heading off to Arthog or Paris the following week. The rehearsal will take place during school hours.

Travel Arrangements

The team will be travelling to the court by minibus and will need to be at the school car park at 8am. It is estimated that the competition will finish at approximately 1.15pm, therefore we expect to return to school by approximately 2.30pm. Please make arrangements to collect your child from the school car park at this time.

Refreshments

We are advised that students should bring their own packed lunch and plenty of water to drink. There may be access to vending machines at the venue, too.
