## Safeguarding

We have been made aware of an escalating online safety concern. Scammers are reaching out to students on social media, claiming to be one of their friends. They tell the student that they have lost their contacts and request that they send their mobile phone number to them in response. The scammers are then using these mobile numbers to access social media accounts, including TikTok. This gives them access to any content that has been saved and published, including their photographs.

We will raise this with all of our students during tutor time and in assemblies but would ask you to speak to your child about this risk and advise them not to share any personal details, unless they can confirm the request is authentic. Please let us know if you have any queries or concerns.
