Dear Parents/Carers,

This is the time of year where the weather starts to get colder and the evenings and mornings are darker. It is also the time that we all start to get coughs and colds. Being in school is important to your child's achievement, wellbeing, and wider development. Evidence shows that the students with the highest attendance throughout their time in school gain the best GCSE results. Research found that students who performed better at the end of secondary school missed fewer days than those who didn't perform as well. This was true for us this summer with students with 95+% attendance achieving significantly higher grades than those without.

Open Day & Evening

Last week we had our open day and evening. During the day, 130 Year 6 students visited the school and experienced a variety of lessons. There were Geography, PE and maths activities as well as an opportunity to write about Frankenstein's monster in a truly immersive English experience. During the evening, we had lots of prospective students, parents and carers visit the school and we received some excellent feedback. We had help from a large number of students and everyone who visited said how helpful and confident our students were. A special thank you to our Year 7 students and senior prefects who spoke at the presentation, they did so with confidence. All of the students that helped with the evening did themselves and the school proud and were excellent ambassadors.

Key Stage 4 course information evening

All of our Year 10 students will be completing a week of work experience at the end of this academic year, the week commencing the 6 July. There are several advantages of taking part in work experience, these include:

- Having the opportunity to try out possible career ideas
- Develop confidence
- Have the opportunity to meet some people in an industry that students are interested in
- Learn new skills from the work placement
- Have an opportunity to apply some of the skills and knowledge that have been learnt in school
